Rules for the 2014 Western Branch Striking Competition

1. Only paid up members of the Western Branch may take part.
2. The competition will be in two parts: Test piece and fall and rise.
3. Each team may ring 5 minutes of called changes or 120 changes in any method which may include Plain Hunt.
4. Each team will have up to 5 minutes practice before the test piece.
5. Before commencing the test piece, **2 whole pulls on the treble** will signify the team is ready to start.
6. Marking will commence immediately and finish when the last bell has set.
7. *If the team is to attempt the fall and rise* then **2 whole pulls on the tenor** will be the signal to the Judges.
8. Marks will be lost for the non-setting of bells.
9. At the end of the fall, bells may finish in either Rounds or Queens. Bells chiming after this will be penalised.
